Membership Eligibility

Membership is open to business professionals who are at least 18 years old. By joining, you confirm that all information is accurate, complete, and up to date. Businesses must be legitimate and legal.

Use of our Community

Members are expected to use our community responsibly and ethically. Prohibited activities include, but are not limited to, harassment, discrimination, spreading hate speech, engaging in illegal activities, and infringing on intellectual property rights.

Membership & Payments

Memberships are for a recommended time period of six months, but you can leave at any time with **one month's written notice**.

You will be invoiced for £46+VAT (£55.20) each month and your payment will be taken directly via Go Cardless.

A one-off payment of £15+VAT (£18) joining fee will be taken for new memberships immediately upon joining.

There is no charge for attending meetings unless your venue has a local meeting room fee.

Termination

The Growth Community reserves the right to terminate your membership at any time for any reason including, without limitation, breach of these Terms.

Expectations of Membership

The Growth Community holds meetings on a fortnightly basis. Your consistent attendance at these meetings is vital for the success of the group and for you to achieve return on your investment.

You are expected to conduct several follow up meetings with every member of your group to get to know each other well enough to explore actionable opportunities to support each other's growth.
